Alex Kirwan and Don Shank will feature their expressive and colorful styling. And how could a show such as this be complete without the dynamic duo behind *Switcheroo*, Amanda Visell and Michelle Valigura, lending their unique interpretations of insects! The artists will be in attendance on opening night to meet fans and discuss their work.

Admission is free for this all-ages event which features a special live performance from the world's longest running modern surf band the *Insect Surfers*, the area's best instrumental band according to L.A. Weekly (2003). Plus, artwork created by actual bugs will also be on display as well! Free refreshments and bug-related snacks will also be provided.
