The book and exhibition of the same name, is the brainchild of artist/illustrator Kevin Dart. Not quite overwhelmed with his lengthy list of freelance work from Pixar, Disney TV, LAIKA, Cartoon Network, Gama-Go, Passion Pictures, and BBC, Kevin aspired to create the ultimate globe-trotting female super spy and set out to immortalize her in book form. For over a year, Kevin has been bringing to life Agent Yuriko a.k.a. Yuki 7.
